- Requests will only be considered from organisations and individuals concerned with sports recognised by SDS or **sportscotland**.
- Consideration will only be given to projects involving individuals and groups with a physical, sensory or learning disability.
- The Scottish Disabled Sports Trust is under no obligation to meet requests forwarded by potential applicants. The Trustees have the final say on whether a grant is approved
- Retrospective applications cannot be processed. Applications must be future focused, i.e. the application must be lodged prior to the event / project / purchase taking place.
